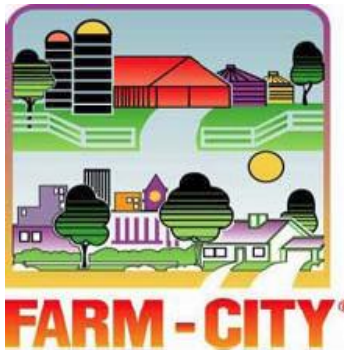

- Take Exit #11 onto The Chantilly Parkway.
- Continue on The Chantilly Parkway for 2.7 miles.
- Turn left onto AL-110/ Vaughn Road and travel 0.5 miles.
- Turn right onto Pike Road and travel 5.3 miles.
- Pike Road becomes Old Carter Hill Road -- continue on Old Carter Hill Road for 0.2 miles.
- The entrance to The Bartlett Ranch is on the left, well-marked with an overhead iron sign
