

Spelling Tic-Tac-Toe

This board includes many different activities to help your child practice his/her spelling words. Your child must choose at least three of the activities to complete for weekly homework. The activities must make a tic-tac-toe line: horizontal, vertical, or diagonal three in a row. Please mark your choices with crayon, marker, etc. Parents, you are encouraged to assist your child as needed to make homework a positive learning experience. This sheet should be turned in on Thursday. Have fun!

<p>Memory Match: Write each word on two cards and play concentration.</p>	<p>Put all 10 words in alphabetical order.</p>	<p>Make a comic strip using your spelling words.</p>
<p>Take a practice spelling test with an adult. Write any missed word 5 times each.</p>	<p>Make and complete a word search using www.puzzlemaker.com</p>	<p>Ransom words-Spell your words by cutting out letters in a newspaper or magazine and gluing them on a piece of paper.</p>
<p>Write your words three times, once in your best handwriting, once as small as you can, and once in funny or fancy letters.</p>	<p>Word Magic- Write the word once, then write it a 2nd time without the first letter, then write it without the first two letters. Repeat until the whole word disappears! Example: SPELL, _PELL, _ _ELL, _ _ _ LL, _ _ _ Repeat for each word!</p>	<p>Silly Sentences Use all your words in five silly sentences.</p>
