

Spelling Tic-Tac-Toe

This board includes many different activities to help your child practice his/her spelling words. Your child must choose at least three of the activities to complete for weekly homework. The activities must make a tic-tac-toe line: horizontal, vertical, or diagonal three in a row. Please mark your choices with crayon, marker, etc. Parents, you are encouraged to assist your child as needed to make homework a positive learning experience. This sheet should be turned in on Thursday. Have fun!

<p>Make a set of flashcards on index cards to study your words.</p>	<p>Draw 15 different shapes. Write a spelling word inside each shape.</p>	<p>Write each of your spelling words using fancy letters. Your letters can have curly-<i>q's</i> or dots or anything else.</p>
<p>Have an adult give you a practice test at home. Be sure the test is checked and signed by an adult.</p>	<p>Put all 15 words in alphabetical order.</p>	<p>Write each word once making the r-controlled vowel pattern (<i>or, ore, our</i>) red and the rest of the word blue.</p>
<p>Write each spelling word in a rainbow of colors. First, write the words with a red crayon. Trace over the words with a blue crayon. Finally, trace the words again with a green crayon.</p>	<p>Sort your spelling words. You may want to sort your words by: number of syllables, beginning sounds, parts of speech (noun, verb, adjective, other), vowel patterns.</p>	<p>Write a sentence for each of ten of the words.</p>
