Write each spelling word in a rainbow of colors. First, write the words with a red crayon. Trace over the words with a blue crayon. Finally, trace the words again with a green crayon.	Sort your spelling words. You may want to sort your words by: number of syllables, beginning sounds, parts of speech (noun, verb, adjective, other), vowel	Write a sentence for each of ten of the words.
