

# Spelling Tic-Tac-Toe

This board includes many different activities to help your child practice his/her spelling words. Your child must choose at least three of the activities to complete for weekly homework. The activities must make a tic-tac-toe line: horizontal, vertical, or diagonal three in a row. Please mark your choices with crayon, marker, etc. Parents, you are encouraged to assist your child as needed to make homework a positive learning experience. <p><b>Memory Match:</b> Write each word on two cards and play concentration.</p>	<p>Put all 15 words in alphabetical order.</p>	<p>Write your spelling words in dots. Then connect the dots with a crayon.</p>
<p><b>Spelling Baseball!</b> Draw 4 bases. A pitcher selects a word. If batter (you) can spell it correctly, you advance one base. You get a point every time you pass home base.</p>	<p>Type your spelling words in the box at <a href="http://vozme.com/index.php?lang=en">http://vozme.com/index.php?lang=en</a> Hit create mp3, download your new mp3 and listen!
