## Bible

- Students will receive Bible notes in the Tuesday folders.


## Math

- Consumable Textbook
- Test Day: Depends on when we finish each chapter
- Math lab will begin in January. Half of the class will go to the math lab while the other half stays in the room for small group instruction then the groups will switch.
- Please practice addition and subtraction math facts with your child on a regular basis.


## Standards Based Grading

- Standards Based Grading will be used in math this year.
- Helps see what skills students are mastering and which skills need more work.


## Reading/Language/AR

- Reading story each week and lessons will include language skills. Tests will be given on Fridays.
- You can access the reading textbook from home, using Think Central. More information will be given later on this!
- Reading Lab will be on Tuesdays and Thursdays with Mrs. Olesen.
-Students are encouraged to READ and take AR tests. We will set goals and points for students to work towards. The goal for $1^{\text {st }} 9$ Weeks will be 15 points!


# Science and Social Studies 

- We will alternate between science and social studies every two to three weeks.
- The science workbook is consumable.
- The social studies textbook can be taken home to study for tests.
- Students will receive notes prior to each test for study use at home.


## Spelling

-Students will receive a set of 15 words each week.
-Words will be listed on the
board and in the weekly
newsletter on my Weebly.
-Tests will be given on Fridays.

## Homework

- Math Homework will be assigned on most Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays.
- Reading and Language study guides will be sent home in note bags each Friday.
- Spelling homework will be a tic tac toe board. Students will need to complete two activities each week, and turn in each Friday morning.
